


Year of construction 2023>

The roll-off protection on the carriageway has been modified on these two lift models.

Note: Retrofitting to lifts before model year 2023 is possible without any problems.

In the front area of the runways, the plug-in plates are replaced by permanently installed roll-off protection plates. In the rear area, the newly designed roll-off protection plates are installed instead of the retaining brackets for the access ramp. These automatically ensure roll-off protection as soon as the carriageway is raised.

Only minor modifications need to be made to the safety catch release linkage. These are swapped at the pivot point at the front and rear. Readjustment is necessary; if necessary, the length of the rods must be shortened by approx. 1 cm. This changes the operating direction of the latch release from 'pushed' to 'pulled', which also simplifies the handling of the release in the lower stroke range.



Installation: Comparison of the models

At the front:

Roll-off protection is bolted directly to the cross member with the carriageway.




At the back:

Roll-off protection flap is bolted directly to the cross member with the track.

All round:

Retaining bracket and plug-in roll guard are not required when using components from model 2023!


Roll guard

Linkage at the back pivot point:

- ← green > year of construction 2023 >
- ← red dotted > formerly year of construction >2023



Linkage at the front pivot point:

- ← green > year of construction 2023 >
- ← red dotted > formerly year of construction >2023



Note: The rods may need to be shortened by approx. 1 cm for an ideal adjustment range

Year of construction 2023>




Lift in park position:

The safety catches are engaged, the lift is blocked.

The hydraulic system and the steel cables are relieved.

Year of construction 2023>



Lift unlocked:

To unlock, move the lift upwards out of the catches.

To lower the lift, push the lever of the safety lock upwards and hold it in this position while lowering.
